

BLOCKING

The phone number of the telephone you are using can be viewed by the called party and may be retained each time you call another person or company who subscribes to Caller ID. **THIS OCCURS EVEN IF YOUR SERVICE IS UNLISTED OR NON-PUBLISHED.** Because there may be occasions when you want to call without having your number displayed, Monitor Telephone has equipped your line with PER CALL BLOCKING. If you feel you must make all of your calls anonymously, you need to order PER LINE BLOCKING.

PER CALL BLOCKING

For most calls you place, we think you'll find it convenient and beneficial to "announce" yourself to Caller ID subscribers. But on those few occasions when you need to call anonymously, you can block the display of your number by dialing *67 (1167 on rotary phone) before you dial the phone number you are calling. This will prevent your number from being delivered on that call.

There is no charge to use PER CALL BLOCKING.

PER LINE BLOCKING

If you do not want the flexibility of PER CALL BLOCKING, and feel you must make all of your calls anonymously, you need to order PER LINE BLOCKING. This service will prevent your number from being displayed on all the calls you make. Instead, the word "Private" or "Anonymous" will display when you call someone who has Caller ID (Please note this may reduce the likelihood of your calls being answered, as even friends and relatives may choose not to pick up calls marked "Anonymous").
